- AMS CAA will request to the transferring competent authority for the following records:
  - □ copy of **initial** or **earliest available** medical Application and Examination report forms;
  - $\Box$  copy of forms and supporting documents from **previous transfers**;
  - □ copy of the most recent medical examinations: ECG; Audiogram; Ophthalmological;
  - □ copy of the current **Medical certificate** and accompanying **reports**;
  - □ **summary** of the relevant medical history verified and signed by the <u>Medical Assessor</u> employed by or acting on behalf of the transferring competent authority.
- <sup>b</sup> Upon receiving records, AMS CAA Latvia will review the documentation. AMS reserves the right to seek any further information or copies of medical records which are deemed necessary. Note: The review process may take several days and may be subject to administrative delays outside of the control of the AMS.

- AMS CAA of Latvia will reissue the EU medical certificate dated from the most recent aero-medical examination, if the current medical certificate and accompanying reports are validated and if there is no change in pilot's medical status since the latest aero-medical examination.
- AMS CAA Latvia will notify the transferring competent authority AMS, once it has reissued the medical certificate and the licence holder has surrendered the previous medical certificate. Until such a notification is received, the transferring competent authority remains responsible for the medical certificate originally issued.
