Reg (EU) 2019/1383

- → Opinions (Part-M GA, SMS in CAMO & Tech Records) voted 28 Feb 2019
- → Regulation (EU) 2019/1383 introduces new Part-ML/-CAO/-CAMO
 - → Adopted: 8 Jul 2019
 - → Published in OJ: 4 Sep 2019
 - → Entry into force: 24 Sep 2019
 - → Applicable from: 24 Marc 2020 (cf. corrigendum)
 - → Also Part-M/-145/-66/-147/-T affected
 - Transition period



Amendment content

- → Due to last minute changes at EASA Committee of February 2019 and after adoption, some missing links or editorials have been spotted in the Annexes of Regulation No 2019/1383.
- → Some feedback → transition measures have been found unclear as regard oversight requirements.
- → The Commission proposed during the last EASA Committee (Oct 2019) a new act to:
 - → make transition measures clearer; and
 - → correct editorials or missing links in the annexes.



Amendment content

- → Transition measures :
 - Alignment of wording between transition measures for CAMO and CAO:
 - Request of a new approval certificate
 - Since then, oversight iaw Part-CAO/Part-CAMO
 - Clarification that Part-CAO or Part-CAMO in transition have 2
 years to correct any findings related to new requirements
 introduced by Part CAO or Part CAMO.
 - No change in application dates.



Amendment content – main comments

→ Agreed during EASA Committee: MSs to send written comments (27 comments received) and discussion during P&CA TeB.

- → Certificates before 24 March 2020 by Subpart F or Subpart G organisations → article amended to cover all approval certificates, ARC issued by NAA and approved AMPs.
- → 24 Sep 2021 revocation of organisation if not in compliance with reg → article amended to allow revoked, limited or suspended if findings of non-compliance with related introduced requirements are not closed (comment on "without further showing").



Amendment content – main comments

→ AMP in ML: derogation to allow AMP approval by NAA → Introduced clear privilege in Part-M Subpart G and Part-CAMO, no need to amend cover regulation.

→ **Delay of applicability date** (different proposals)

→ Other missing references: M.1,... → all accepted

→ Qualification of ARS in Subpart F and Part-145 → accepted




Amendment content – main comments


→ Subpart F and G refer to "unlimited" approval certificate → changed to align with cover regulation and template, until 24 Sept 2021

→ Questions: Is it intended to **reissue** the **certificates** to have the validity date of Subpart F and...? → **No**

→ Applicability date Reg (EU) 2019/1384 Mixed operation → CAW provisions enforceable on the 24 March 2020, no change needed





